

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a JWEMC member or a child or legal ward of a JWEMC member who has been a member in good standing for at least 12 consecutive months at the application deadline of March 31, 2011. Only one scholarship will be awarded per family per year.
2. A student can receive the JWEMC scholarship only one time. It is not renewable. The term of the scholarship will be for one continuous academic year beginning with the fall semester or quarter.
3. The scholarship monies can be used by undergraduate students to attend, on a full-time basis, any Alabama university, college, or junior college.
4. A first-time college student applying for the JWEMC scholarship must have graduated from high school with at least a "C" average or its equivalent. High school students who apply must be seniors.
5. A continuing undergraduate student seeking the scholarship must have received a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale on all prior college work.
6. This application must be filled out and returned to JWEMC by 4:30 p.m. on March 31, 2011.
7. The recipients will be chosen in a random drawing at the Annual Membership Meeting. Members of the JWEMC Board of Directors and JWEMC employees and their children are not eligible.
8. Persons whose names are drawn will be required to provide JWEMC with an official transcript verifying their eligibility within 30 days after the drawing.
9. The scholarship funds will be paid to the colleges at the beginning of each semester (or quarter) upon presentation of an official receipt for the payment of full-time undergraduate tuition. To receive the second semester (or quarter) payment, a student must provide evidence that he or she successfully completed at least 12 semester hours (or 8 quarter hours) with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
10. If the original scholarship recipient loses eligibility for a spring or second semester grant, the \$1,000 remaining is to be offered to alternates in the order that they were chosen at the Annual Meeting in April. If an alternate accepts the remaining \$1,000, he/she will not be eligible for any future scholarship offerings under this JWEMC program. If an alternate declines the \$1,000, he/she will be eligible for future drawings.
11. In order to properly process recipients, transcripts of grades must be turned in to Benita Owens no later than 10 days after the winner receives official notice. Notices will be sent by registered mail.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. You must be at least a senior in high school to enter. First-time freshmen, continuing college students or persons returning to college to finish an undergraduate degree are also eligible to enter.
2. All blanks must be filled out or your application will be voided. Your application must be signed on the space provided.
3. Your application must be postmarked on or before March 31, 2011 or it will be voided. Only one application allowed per applicant. Duplicates will be voided.
4. If you are living on your own, away from home, you can not apply under your parents' name. YOU must be a JWEMC member in order to apply. EXCEPTION: If you are living away from home specifically to attend college, but your PERMANENT address is still your parents' home and your parents are JWEMC members, you may apply.
5. Graduate or doctoral students are ineligible.
